Heading: Paradise Found

Synopsis: A breakthrough in Jim's walk with God occurred when he was led by the Spirit to forgive from the heart every sin committed by everyone who has ever lived on the earth, past, present and future. Two nine-step prayers are presented as God's plan for forgiveness, one for time present and one for time past to conception in the womb.
